

Complying with Part 12 of the Ontario Building Code

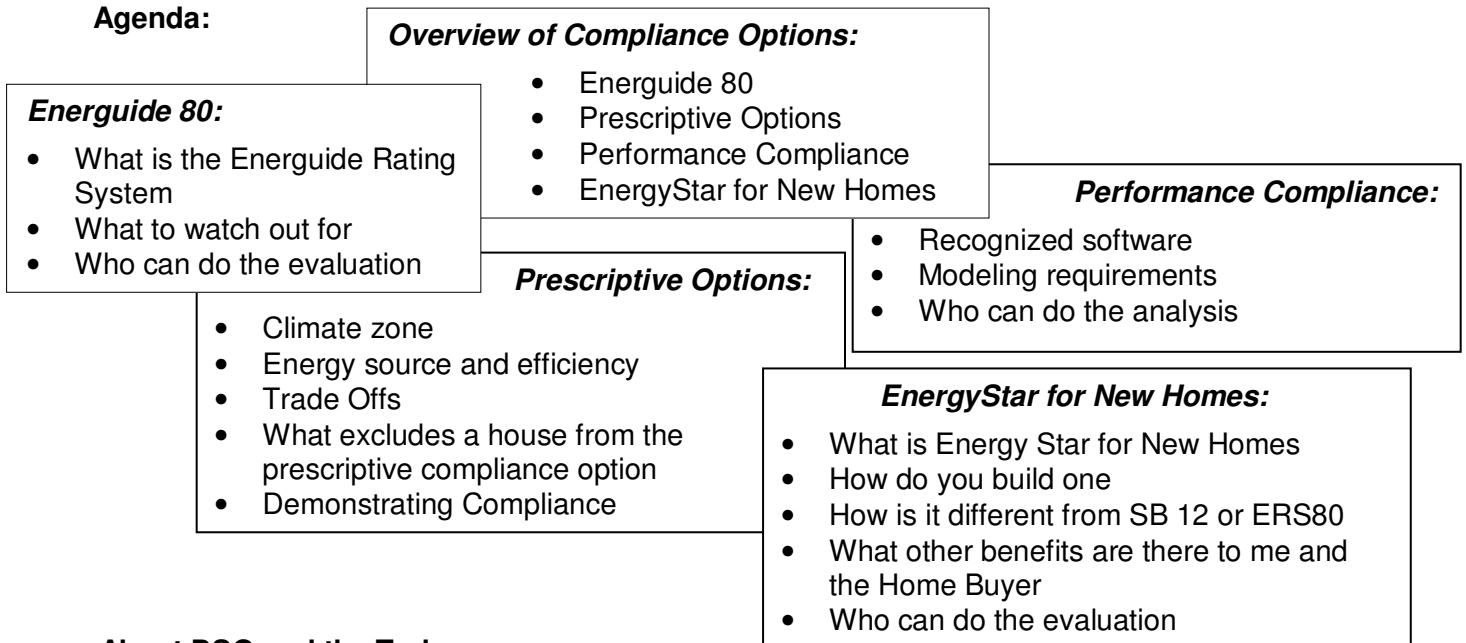
Overview:
